Meeting was called to order by Commissioner Willis also present was Town Manager Mimi Willis, Secretary.

Commissioner Willis read the following statement:

Since the Town has only one Commissioner until the special election, there is not a quorum at tonight's meeting.

I can't allow the vacancy of two Commissioner positions to bring the operations of the Town to a halt, however. The citizens of the Town depend upon us for public safety, public works, and public services. As a result, I am approving a series of bill payments tonight. I have asked the Town Manager to submit for approval only those bills that were routinely approved when we had three Commissioners and that are essential to the operation of the Town pending election of Commissioners to fill the two vacant positions. I have also asked the Town Manager to hold all other bills until we have a full complement of Commissioners and to notify the suppliers of goods and services of the delay and the anticipated date of approval of the payment of those bills. Finally, I am asking the Town Manager to include on the agenda for the first meeting after the new Commissioners are sworn in an agenda item for ratification by the full board of my approvals of these bill payments tonight.
